**HILLTOP PROJECT COMPLETED**  
 Huff Run has a new reclamation project! Located off of Lindesree Rd. in Tuscarawas County, the Hilltop AMD Reclamation project site began construction in January 2013 and was completed by June of the same year. The site was contributing 3-5 pounds of acid a day, for a total of over 50 tons of acid a year. The construction consisted of recontouring and revegetating 11 acres of the drainage before it enters Huff Run. The project was designed by ODNR Division of Mineral Resources Management (DMRM) and constructed by Red Malcuit, Inc. of Strasburg for a project total of just over \$287,000. Grant funding was provided by ODNR-DMRM and Ohio EPA through their \$19 grant program.
