ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Directors, Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District, 2050 Reiser Avenue, SE, New Philadelphia, Ohio 44663 until 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 24, 2020 for the Tappan Marina Renovation as set forth in Bidding Documents on file. At said time and place, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following project work:

Tappan Marina Renovation

Due to the COVID-19 situation, access to the MWCD Annex Building located at 2050 Reiser Ave. SE, New Philadelphia, OH 44663, is restricted. As a result, the bid opening will be conducted as follows:

- It is the bidder's responsibility to make sure that the bids are received at the correct time and location.
- Bids may be dropped off in person at the Annex Building beginning 2 hours prior to the scheduled bid opening time. The drop off location is within the building alcove / foyer.
- An MWCD employee or agent will date stamp each bid submittal upon receipt.
- Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Annex building facility in an open air location.
- Individuals will not be permitted to examine the bid submittal packages on-site. Scanned copies of bid documents can be obtained upon request. Any such requests should list specific pages desired for review.

Bidding Documents can be seen at the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD) Engineering Services Office, 2050 Reiser Avenue, SE, New Philadelphia, Ohio 44663. Plan holders registered with AA Blueprint at the time of the most recent bid opening on April 9, 2020 will receive documents at no charge. For those not previously registered, documents may be obtained upon payment of \$400.00 (plus shipping and handling if required). Payment shall be made to AA Blueprint. Bidding Documents are not returnable for refund.

Bidders shall obtain bidding documents from AA Blueprint to ensure that they receive all addenda and communications. MWCD reserves the right to reject the proposal of any bidder not registered with AA Blueprint as a plan holder of official Bidding Documents.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount and form as stated in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids shall be subject to the condition that the right is reserved to hold bids for a period not longer than 60 days after date of opening and/ or to award at any time during the period.
