

MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY DISTRICT CONSERVATION PARTNER ASSESSMENT CREDITS PROGRAM

"Giving credit where credit's due."

The Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District's maintenance assessment was established to protect and enhance the works of the District, and to support conservation efforts throughout the watershed. Though all landowners have an equal stake in the management of the natural resources throughout the District, it is important to recognize individual efforts in conservation, watershed stewardship, and implementation of best management practices. Accordingly, a credits program has been developed, and will be applied judiciously in recognition of those who strive to enhance the quality of life of the watershed's residents through their conscientious stewardship and protection of our natural heritage.

Qualified landowners (including non-residential, non-agricultural, non-vacant parcels with an annual maintenance assessment greater than the minimum assessment or 1 E.R.U.), can submit their stewardship project(s) or best management practice(s) for review and potential assessment credit by completing the application form attached and returning it to the address listed below. Examples of eligible projects and practices and their credit values can be found on the matrix attached. Both the application and credits matrix, and additional information can be found on the District's website at <u>www.mwcd.org</u>. Completed applications are due annually by March 31st.

Please fill out all contact and property information sections. Be sure to include the parcel identification number and property use code for the parcel(s) containing the project or best management practice. Both the parcel identification number, and the property use code, can be found on your property tax form. Describe projects or best management practices in the space provided, and attach drawings, plans, or photos if necessary. For watershed education programs, please provide program description, listing in school curriculum, and any related flyers and/or registration forms.

Applications will be reviewed, and notifications sent in a timely manner. During the initial year of the assessment credits program, checks will be issued to parcel owners in the amount of the approved credit. Thereafter, credits awarded will be reflected in a reduced maintenance assessment in the following year, for the remainder of a period of five years. Education programs must be scheduled and held throughout the five-year period. Re-application will be necessary to continue receiving any assessment credits past each five-year period.
