WHAT IS A "SEASONAL CAMPER"?

A seasonal camper is one who maintains a seven month camping permit April 1 through October 31. Being a seasonal camper provides a number of advantages including camping rates that are discounted significantly over the regular nightly rate and the convenience of having first option of the same campsite year after year. Not to mention, your camper is ready and waiting for you at a moment's notice.

How do I get started?

In order to keep the balance of seasonal and daily campers, there is a limit to the number of seasonal campsites that are permitted each year. If you are interested in becoming a seasonal camper, contact the park to determine if open campsites are currently available or if you will need to enter the lottery, or placed on a waiting list.

What is the seasonal camper lottery?

In an effort to keep the process fair for everyone, a lottery is held every year in **March** at each campground. Established seasonal campers, who are up to date on the current year's fees have the ability to retain their campsite year after year. If they choose to move sites, they would need to enter the 1st lottery where they can select an available seasonal campsite. "We have been seasonally camping since 1989 and we have met some very nice people and made some nice friends over the years. We always look forward to going back every spring. Great place to spend the summers."

Anyone who would like to become a new seasonal camper will then have the opportunity to select a site from any remaining available seasonal campsites following the first lottery. If you are not able to obtain a site, you have the option to be placed on a waiting list when a site becomes available.

A seasonal camper who decides mid-season to sell their camper will be provided a pro-rated refund for the remaining days on the permit, and the site will be offered to the next person on the waiting list.
